



Discovery Zone After - School Program (Revised and effective 8-20-19)

What is Discovery Zone?

Discovery Zone is an after school program designed to provide students with homework assistance, as well as a safe environment while parents/guardians are working. It is not intended as a babysitting service for non-employed parents. Sonora Elementary Rules will be enforced.

What are the hours of operation?

Discovery Zone is open Monday - Friday from Dismissal - 5:30 throughout the school year. The program will be available when students are dismissed early from school. However, Discovery Zone will be closed on school holidays and early dismissal days prior to school holidays.

Who may attend?

Students in Pre-Kindergarten through 6th grade may attend. Students that attend must be potty-trained. Participation is limited to the first 60 students registered.

Where is Discovery Zone?

Discovery Zone is located in the portable buildings located on 1st Street outside the Primary Building.

What is the cost to attend?

The cost is \$30 per week for the first child on regular priced lunch OR \$20 per week for the first child on free or reduced lunch, and \$5 for each additional sibling. Drop-ins are not allowed. Payment for the week is due in FULL on Monday morning, and is required for participation. Please make payments in the elementary office.

How do I register my child?

Parents/guardians may register students by completing the attached registration form. Please complete one form per child attending. Registration forms must be completed and returned to the Primary Office.

What happens if I am late picking up my child?

You will be assessed an additional \$5 for each additional 15 minutes past 5:30. Repeated occurrences of late pickup may result in loss of Discovery Zone participation.
