Third Grade Teachers

Schedules:

This year, 3rd grade will travel to four different teachers throughout the day. Each class will start the day with their homeroom teacher and then travel to specials. When students return from specials at 9:00, they will stay with their homeroom teacher for their first class on Monday's and Tuesday's and travel with their homeroom class at 10:10, 1:05 and 2:15. On Wednesday-Friday, students will start their first class with a different teacher each day.

Assignment Sheets and Discipline:

Assignment sheets and discipline grades will be sent home every Monday, and are to be returned signed by Friday. Parents will also have the option to sign up for text message and email alerts regarding student's homework. The sign up for Parent Edge is included in your packet.

3rd grade uses **Class Dojo** as our classroom management tool to track behavior and citizenship grades. Parents have the option to sign up for weekly reports emailed to them detailing their child's behavior throughout the week. Our grading period for behavior is Monday-Friday, and if a student scores below a 70 on their behavior for the week, they will not participate in Fun Friday (this includes Pep Rally's). Teachers will print and send home weekly behavior reports the following Monday. These are expected to be returned signed by a parent.

Lunch Detention:

Homework is expected to be returned on time. Failure to do so will result in lunch detention.

Progress Reports and Report Cards:

Report Cards will be sent home every six weeks in your student's Wednesday Folder. These are expected to be returned signed the following day. Progress reports will be sent home after the third week of every six weeks and are expected to be returned the following day signed by a Parent.

Procedures for the first day of school:

Students will go to auditorium located inside of Intermediate building. Directions will be given from there.

Dismissal time: Mon.-Thurs. 3:30, Friday 3:00 **Pick up Location:** Outside of Rock building (3rd Grade Line)
